

Fun Activities for Library Special

Choose one activity a week to complete the weeks following spring break. You can also do an activity I had previously posted on my Teacher Webpage if desired. These activities are designed to be simple and fun. If there is more than one child in your house, feel free to have them do the activity together.

1. Complete a scavenger hunt to locate items that start with the same first letter. Then, use those items to form the shape of the letter you chose.
2. Read any directions/instructions aloud (possibly with help from a parent or older sibling) and try to do what the directions/instructions say to do. This would be great for playing a game, making a kite or paper airplane, or cooking, for example.
3. Build one of your favorite book characters out of blocks, legos, Play-Doh, or other objects that are available to you.
4. Practice rhyming today (maybe do a rhyming rap) or read a rhyming poem or nursery rhyme.
5. Retell something you read or listened to using puppets or toys. Act out what you read.
6. Put seven objects in a room in ABC order. Label each object with the name of that item with a small piece of paper.
7. Read something out loud in a silly voice.
8. Listen to one of my read alouds posted on Facebook and make a comment.
9. Draw your favorite part of a book you have read or listened to. You can draw it on paper, outside with sidewalk chalk, or however you wish and with what you have available to use.
